









































Historical and present local community involvement in Musquash Estuary resource use and protection

Musquash Estuary Marine Protected Area (MPA) was nominated as a candidate MPA in 1998 by the Conservation Council of New Brunswick with the support of the Fundy North Fishermen's Association. It was designated as a MPA on December 14, 2006. The natural resources in the area have been important in the development of the Musquash community and there are strong historical use by the residents of the area. The Musquash community also supported the establishment of the MPA and local residents are today part of the Musquash Advisory Committee.

Residents provide local knowledge and experience to assist in the management of the MPA. In this presentation, which will include video clips, we will provide information captured in a recently completed oral history project to describe how the natural resource use by the community has changed over time. We will also illustrate how the participation of local residents aided the establishment and how they continue to be involved in the management of the MPA.
